

(RE)TURN TEXAS BLUE RESOLUTION

Whereas, to **(RE)TURN** Texas Blue, Democrats must Rebuild From The Precinct Level Up; and

Whereas, to **Build From The Bottom Up**, Democratic Precinct Chairs, County Parties, Clubs and Organizations, Officeholders and Candidates need better access to on-going polling data and comprehensive data analytics to guide voter registration targeting and to set voter turnout targets precinct by precinct, district by district for State House and State Senate Districts as well as for commissioners precincts and city council and school board districts across the state so that TDP, county parties and candidates can better monitor voter turnout during elections and can thereby more timely, cost effectively and efficiently deploy get out the vote (GOTV) personnel and financial resources; and

Whereas, to better unify and coordinate Democrats across Texas, TDP should establish a statewide Alliance of Democratic Clubs and Organizations and in addition to daily press releases also create a weekly messaging memo and daily talking points that go out by email and text message to all our elected officials, candidates, precinct chairs, county party chairs, clubs and organizations, allied organizations and primary voters; and

Whereas, Building From The Bottom Up also requires more comprehensive training for Precinct Chairs and County Party Chairs, their hard-work and service should be recognized annually with Precinct Chairs of the Year and County Party Chair of the Year Awards; and

Whereas, TDP must ensure that as a statewide party, we have a Precinct Chair in every precinct across the State and a viable and active County Party in all 254 counties in Texas, TDP must also help fund an Executive Director for each County Party; and

Whereas, to win statewide races TDP and Democratic donors must invest in rebuilding the party's presence, infrastructure and political power and clout in rural counties all across the State starting in East Texas and the Panhandle down to the Valley and out to West Texas so that rural Democrats will know that they are not alone and TDP will fight to protect them and help their communities;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the plans and strategies outlined above, as well as the creation of a comprehensive set of By-Laws for the operation of the SDEC, be adopted and implemented immediately.
